Habitat for Humanity of Hall County (“HFH”, “we” or “us”) seeks to protect your personally identifiable information (“PII”). As a user of this website (the “Site”), we will take appropriate measures to protect the PII you provide to us as well as any PII collected from you through your use of the Site. We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time and will update the last updated date above.

What Information Is Collected?

We (or our third party providers) collect PII from individual visitors, volunteers, donors or online store customers when you provide it voluntarily through this Site. The PII we collect may include data such as names, addresses, zip/postal codes, telephone numbers, e-mail addresses, birth dates, driver’s license numbers, credit card details, or volunteer event attendance. It may also include web browser data that we may use for analytics and Site functionality purposes, including using web browser cookies to improve your user experience. Types of collected web browser data may also include device type, device country location and how individuals were referred to the site.

If you would like more information about what PII we collect, would like us to stop using your PII, or simply wish to unsubscribe from our mailing list, please contact us at the contact email address noted above. Please also note that certain third parties that assist us with providing services, may also give you the ability to unsubscribe on their materials and sites. These options to unsubscribe are generally placed at the bottom of a page or website.

We do not intentionally collect PII from, or direct this Site to, people under 13 years old. What Do We Do With Information?

We use PII in support of our organization’s mission. Our use of your PII may include such activities as sending you information about our programs and activities or asking you to donate to our organization or store. We may also use your PII when you purchase items from our online store or when you sign up to volunteer to build a site or work in our store. Managing a non-profit organization may also require us to share your PII with certain third parties. We maintain reasonable security measures to protect your PII from unauthorized use. For example, we store the PII you provide on servers with limited access. While no protections are completely secure, we strive to apply best practices to protect your PII from unauthorized physical and digital access. As a result, while we strive to protect your information, we cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit or receive from us.
